

INFORMATION CLAUSE

ATL Renting Sp. z o.o.

Pursuant to article 13 of Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: GDPR) we inform you of the following:

I. Who controls my personal data?

1. The controller of your personal data is: ATL Renting Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Jasin, ul. Rabowicka 9A, 62-020 Jasin, KRS no 0000237905 (hereinafter: "Controller").
2. You may contact the Personal Data Controller by sending a letter via traditional post to: 62-020 Jasin, ul. Rabowicka 9A or via email to: biuro@atlrenting.pl.

II. What is the purpose of processing?

As a Controller, we will process your personal data for the following purposes:

1. to enter into and perform contracts in the course of our business or to take requested steps prior to entering into a contract,
2. to comply with our legal obligations as a Controller,
3. to send out marketing content and the newsletter,
4. to pursue our legitimate interests as a Controller, for instance: to exercise legal claims.

III. What is the legal basis for personal data processing?

The legal basis for personal data processing by the Controller is:

- a) article 6(1)(b) GDPR, i.e. performance of a contract or taking steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract,
- b) article 6(1)(c) GDPR, i.e. compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject,
- c) article 6(1)(f) GDPR, i.e. legitimate interests pursued by the Controller,
- d) article 6(1)(a) GDPR, i.e. obtaining consent for the processing of personal data.

IV. Period for which the personal data will be stored

Personal data will be stored for a period necessary to ensure the proper performance of the contract. The storage periods result from the applicable laws or the Controller's legitimate interests.

V. Who can gain access to my personal data?

We may disclose your personal data to:

- a) Employees and associates – authorised by the Controller,
- b) Data processors, i.e. entities providing us with advisory services, as well as legal, tax and accounting assistance; entities providing us with services related to IT and programming support,
- c) Public administration bodies and other authorities pursuant to the applicable laws,
- d) We do not transfer personal data to a third country outside the European Union or international organisations.

VI. What are my rights?

1. At all times, you have the right obtain from the Controller:
 - a) access to your processed personal data and a copy of it,
 - b) rectification (amendment) of your data,
 - c) erasure, restriction of processing or objection to the data processing,
 - d) data portability,
 - e) complaint to the President of the Polish Personal Data Protection Office (UODO).
2. Some of the rights may not apply to the processing of data within the framework of contracts made.

VII. Can I object to personal data processing?

Irrespective of the rights listed in VI, you have the right to object to personal data processing at any time pursuant to article 6(1)(f) GDPR. The Controller will then no longer process your personal data for those purposes unless the Controller is able to demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the given data subject or such personal data is necessary for the Controller in the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

VIII. Right to withdraw consent

At all times, you have the right to withdraw consent to personal data processing (in the scope covered by the consent), but the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

IX. Freely given personal data

You are providing your personal data freely, however if you refuse to provide the data, we may not be able to enter into a contract or properly perform a service.

X. How is my personal data protected?

1. Please be advised that our personal data processing is secure, compliant with the terms and conditions of service and provisions of the law, including GDPR.
2. We do our best to ensure all the possible physical, technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data against accidental or intentional destruction, accidental loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure, use or access, in accordance with all the applicable laws.

XI. Miscellaneous

Please be advised that the Controller does not engage in automated decision-making and that personal data is not subject to profiling.
